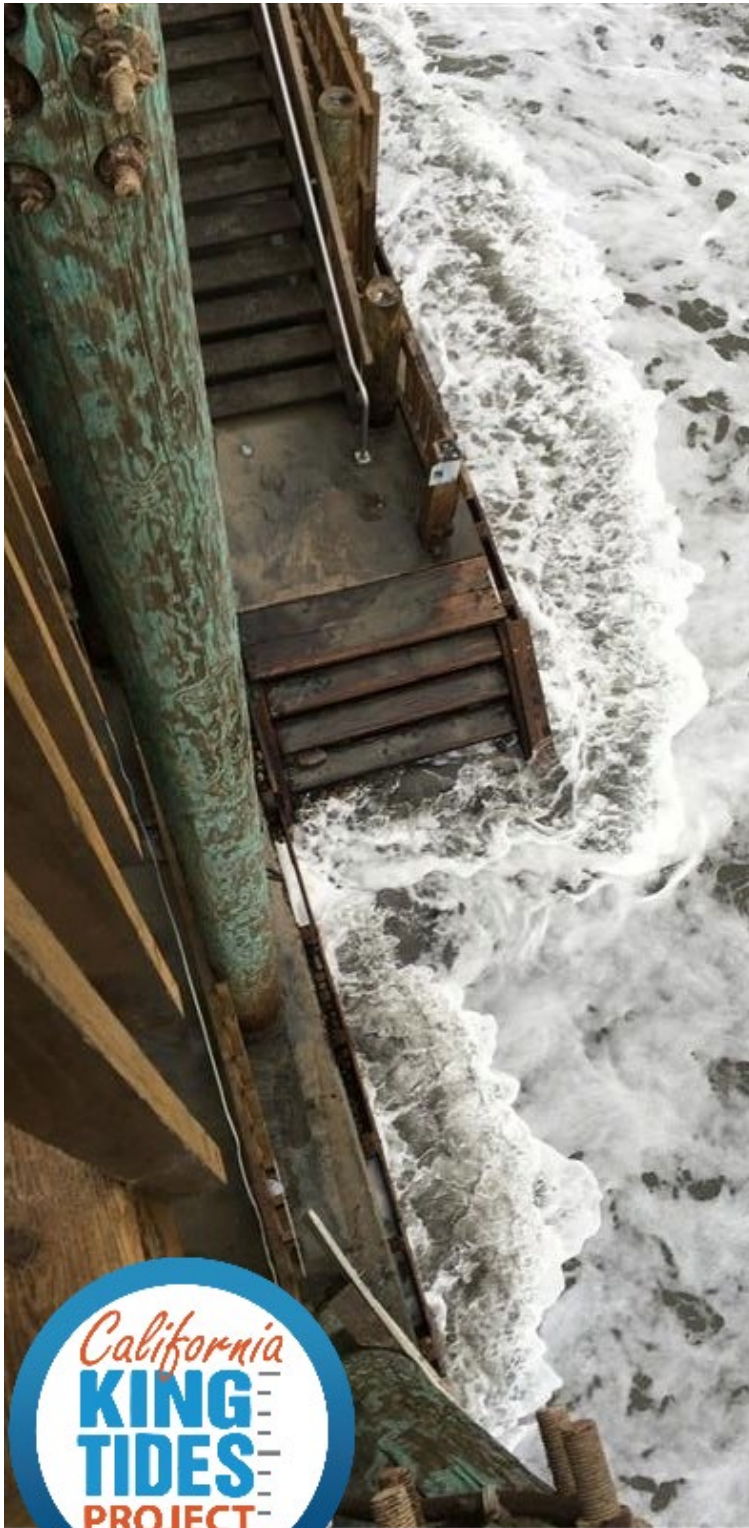


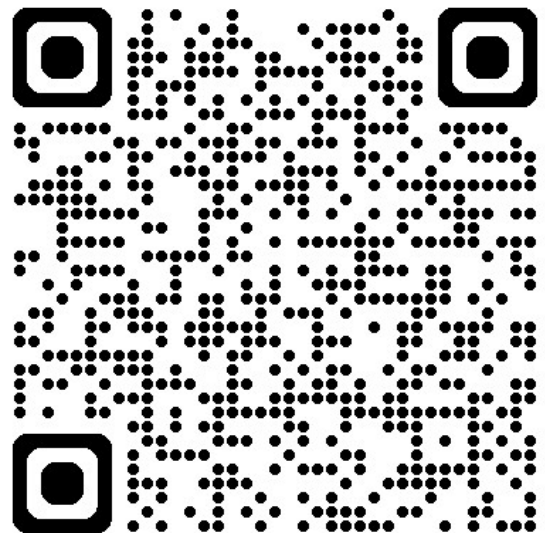
California King Tides Project: How to Participate

November 15-17 & December 13-15, 2024



1. Visit the shoreline as close to high tide as you can. Be careful not to disturb shorebirds that may be further upland than usual. Be Safe - Don't turn your back on the ocean.
2. Choose a location where you can take a photograph that shows the height of the water in relation to a stationary landmark such as a cliff, bridge, sea wall, pier, etc. You can also photograph high tide flooding on roads or in wetlands.
3. Make sure that you have Location Services turned on for your camera app, and/or take careful note of where you're standing.
4. Take your photo!
5. Upload your photo using this QR code or via coastal.ca.gov/kingtides. You can stay private or you can provide your email to get updates on the project.
