Background on Periodic Review

• COASTAL ACT section 30519.5 requires (in part)

...The commission shall... review every certified LCP to determine whether such program is being effectively implemented in conformity with the policies of ...[the Coastal Act.]...



Marina Del Rey LCP History

- Effectively certified 1984
- Comprehensively updated 1996
- Amended August 1990 and February 1996
- 14 County Issued Permits
- 5 Appeals



Periodic Review Steps

- Assess changed conditions
- Identify new information since certification
- Evaluate outcome of permits and amendments
- Determine whether LCP is being effectively implemented in conformity with the coastal act
- Make suggested recommendations



Results of a Periodic Review

- Suggested changes to policies or ordinances and future amendments
- Revised procedures
- Recommendations to other local or state agencies that have responsibilities
- Recommendations for improved intergovernmental coordination

- Public services (transportation, water, sewer, etc.)
- LCP procedures and administration
